## **LITESCAPE ANNOUNCES SUPPORT FOR MICROSOFT LIVE MEETING AND OCS 2007**

*LiteScape Extends OnCast to support "One-Touch Web Conferencing" for Live Meeting from IP Phones*

OneTouch Live Meeting, a feature of LiteScape's OnCast Unified Communications application suite, allows users to create or join web meetings instantly from their IP phones. With OnCast, users can search for contacts in any corporate directory from their phone, and with the push of a single button, instantly invite selected participants to a Live Meeting web meeting. The OnCast service sends the Live Meeting invitation out to all invited participant's phones. With the click of the OneTouch button on their desktop IP or mobile phone, OnCast launches an invited participant's web browser--pre-populating all meeting codes and passwords--and then automatically dials into the conference bridge to connect them to the audio. This service saves a significant amount of time for all meeting participants and avoids the hassles normally associated with starting a web meeting. OnCast's OneTouch Live Meeting makes collaboration easier than ever, reducing time-to-meeting; and maximizing use of high-value people resources.

LiteScape also announced today its support of Microsoft OCS 2007. LiteScape integrates Office Communicator—including conferencing and Live Meeting capabilities—with an enterprise's IP Phone and PBX infrastructure. Now, with LiteScape and OCS 2007, users can take advantage of the power of the OnCast Unified Communications application suite – including Click to Dial, Device Presence (to see if users are on a call), or powerful Call Context functionality to answer, forward, and deflect calls directly from pop-up windows on their PCs. These features can be delivered across most major IP phone and PBX vendor's products, enabling an enterprise to easily deploy this capability with its existing infrastructure.
